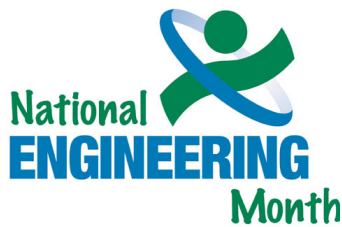




Durham Region Popsicle Stick Bridge Competition March 30, 2019

Our contest will be held **Saturday March 30, 2019** at Durham College / University of Ontario Institute of Technology in Oshawa. The contest will start at 11:00 a.m. and will go until all bridges are tested.

This contest is **open to all students from grades 4 - 8**. There is a Junior category (Grade 4 - 6) and an Intermediate category (Grades 7-8). Each teams may consist of 1 to 4 students.

Bridges must **be built before the competition** to allow time for the glue to dry. A full copy of the **rules / specifications** is on our **website**.

Prizes will be awarded to the strongest bridge in each category. As well additional prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the judging staff.

There is an **entrance fee of \$5 per bridge** to be tested, payable at the competition. Pizza and prizes will be provided to all participants.
